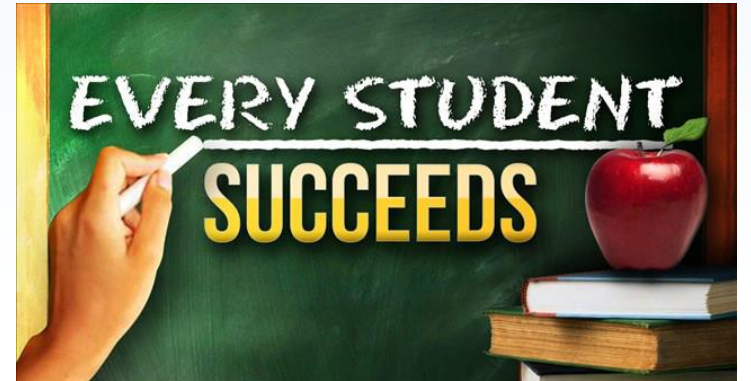

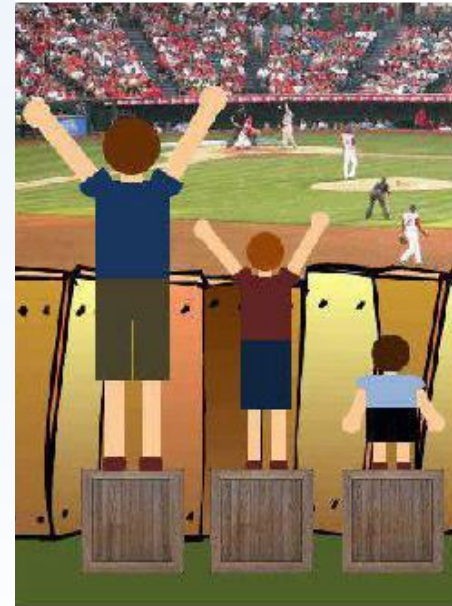
Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) Recent Reauthorization

- Improving America's Schools Act (IASA) 1994
- No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB) 2001
- Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) 2015
(to be implemented in FY18)

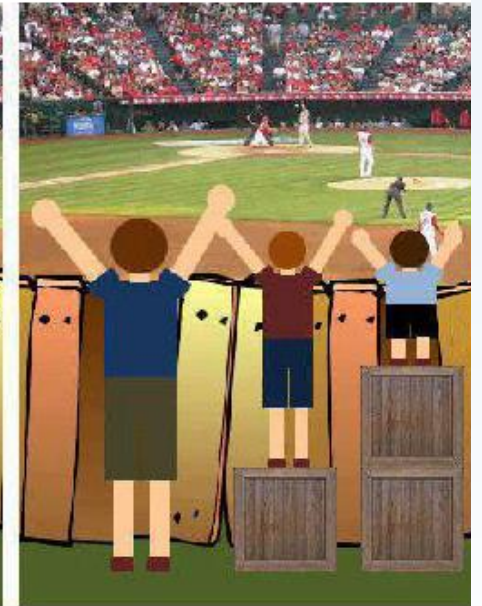

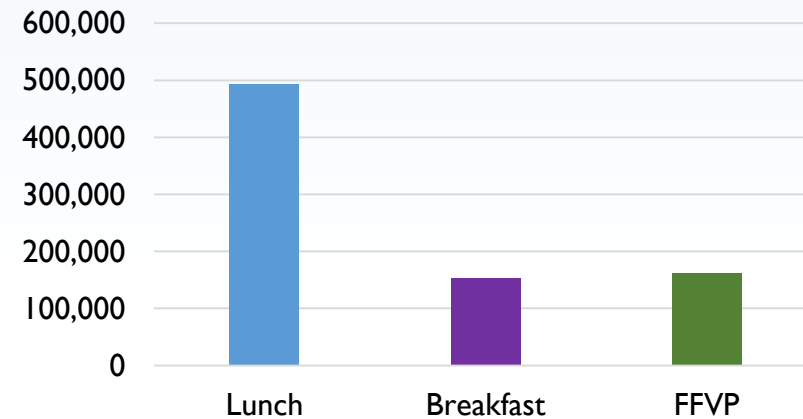

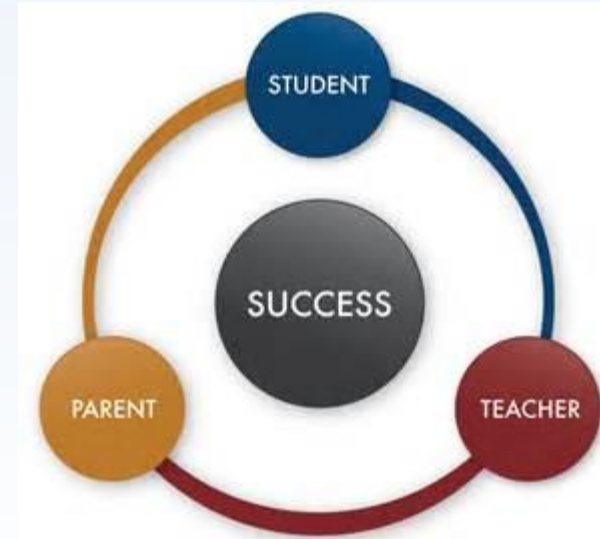
